On July 4-5, IcARUS six partner cities (Lisbon, Nice, Riga, Rotterdam, Stuttgart, and Turin) met in Paris to present the development of their novelty tools in the **four areas** identified by local and regional authorities as their primary security challenges:

1. Preventing juvenile delinquency
2. Preventing and reducing trafficking and organised crime
3. Designing and managing safe public spaces
4. Preventing radicalisation leading to violent extremism

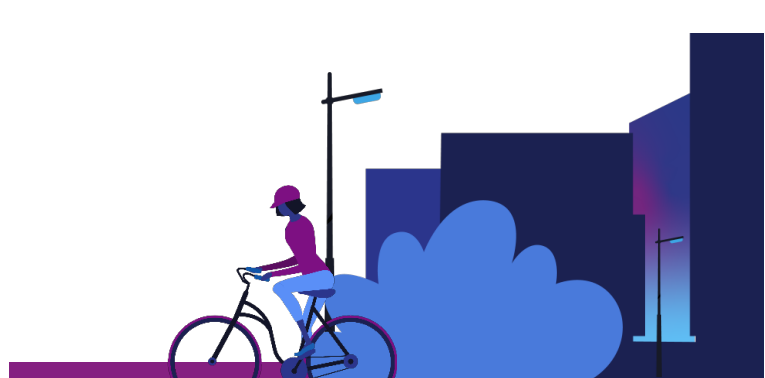
